Electrical sockets not overloaded	
Electrical cords secure	
Fire escape route planned & rehearsed	
Fire extinquishers charged, easily accessible	
Smoke detectors present, operating	
Carbon monoxide detectors present, operating	
Curtains off floor & heating elements	
Safe storage of important papers
