## Spotlight on Member - Joe Dupras

In the 1970s when I was earning a Ph.D. at S.U.N.Y. Binghamton, I didn't imagine that I would teach English at UAF for 31 years (1979-2010). I spent my first academic year in Fairbanks without Rheba; we had married in 1978, but she stayed in Carlisle, PA, as a librarian at Dickinson College while I tested the conditions for professional survival in The Great Land. Our cross-country drive in a little red Dodge Colt packed with lots of precious items--including Malkin, our first cat--took us to UC-Berkeley for an NEH Summer Seminar. Arriving in Fairbanks, Rheba soon got a tenure-track position in Rasmuson Library, and we retired together as professors emeriti. I'm an enthusiastic golfer, reader of "classics," OLLI teacher and student. My UAF students nicknamed me "Dr. Doom" ("Know Joe, know fear!"). I myself know fear when I face house repairs. Thus AAH-Fairbanks keeps me from dooming myself and our sometimes cantankerous home. Life is an odyssey; the joy in it is getting where you're meant to be.
